### **Mayor Frank G. Jackson Scholarship Program Information**

The Mayor Frank G. Jackson Scholarship Program has been established to support City of Cleveland employees, their children and Cleveland Metropolitan School District students who are interested in pursuing a college education.

We will offer City of Cleveland employees and their children, an opportunity to apply for one of the following scholarships:

- Ten children of City of Cleveland employees who are graduating seniors entering into their first year of enrollment at a post-secondary institution (two-year college or four-year college/university) will be awarded \$2,000.00 each.
- Nine children of City of Cleveland employees who are currently enrolled at a four-year college will receive \$1,000.00 each.
- Ten City of Cleveland employees earning a bachelors degree (going to school part-time) will receive \$1,000.00 each.

We will offer Cleveland Metropolitan School District students an opportunity to apply for one of the following scholarships:

- Ten Cleveland Metropolitan School District graduating seniors entering into their first year of enrollment at a post-secondary institution (two-year college or four-year college/university) will be awarded \$2,000.00 each.
- One \$2,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to a student who will be attending a Historically Black College or University.
