Fleet Avenue Rehabilitation Project

Work Zone Revision: Independence Road to Broadway Avenue

CLEVELAND – On Wednesday, May 4, weather permitting, the contractor of the Fleet Avenue rehabilitation project will revise the work zone to close the intersection of East 53rd Street and Fleet Avenue. The intersection closure will remain in place for a minimum of 60 days and is necessary to construct the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District green infrastructure facility. The existing traffic zone on Fleet Avenue from East 49th Street to Broadway Avenue will remain in place.

Advance notice signs will be posted to advise Fleet Avenue traffic of construction. Access to all driveways will be maintained during this phase of the project. The Fleet Avenue rehabilitation project will reconstruct 1.03 miles of Fleet Avenue. This includes pavement replacement between Independence Road to East 65th Street and resurfacing operations on Fleet Avenue from East 65th Street to Broadway Avenue. The project construction will also include streetscape improvements and a NEORS D stormwater facility. The entire project is scheduled for completion by July 2016.
