Fleet Avenue Rehabilitation Project

Work Zone Revision: Independence Road to Broadway Avenue

CLEVELAND – On Tuesday, June 9, weather permitting, the intersection of East 61st Street and Fleet Avenue will close as a work zone revision will be implemented for the Fleet Avenue rehabilitation project. The intersections of East 59th Street and East 63rd Street at Fleet Avenue will be reopened prior to the East 61st Street closure.

The East 61st Street intersection closure will remain in place for a minimum of 21 days and is necessary to replace concrete pavement at intersections. The existing traffic zone on Fleet Avenue from East 49th to East 65th Street, which is currently restricted to eastbound traffic, will remain in place. Advance notice signs will be posted to advise Fleet Avenue traffic of construction. Access to all driveways will be maintained during this phase of the project.

The Fleet Avenue rehabilitation project will reconstruct 1.03 miles of Fleet Avenue and include pavement replacement between Independence Road to East 65th Street and resurfacing from East 65th Street to Broadway Avenue. Project construction will also include streetscape improvements and a NEORS D stormwater facility. The entire project is scheduled for completion by July 2016.
